Ingredients

Serves 1

- 60ml gin
- 120ml ginger ale or ginger beer
- Half a lime
- Small handful of mint leaves

Method

- Chop the half lime into slices
- Add these along with some ice and the small handful of mint leaves to a glass
- Pour in the gin and ginger ale or ginger beer
- Stir well with a long spoon

Alcohol-free version: replace the gin with the juice from half a lime.
